- SCOPUS (operated by “Elsevier”, The Netherlands) is largest abstract and Index database of peer-reviewed literature (scientific journals, books and conference proceedings) from more than 5000 publishers. It provides access to more than 120,000 Books and 22,000 peer reviewed journal titles of which 4200 open access journals. Content coverage as follows:
    - ✓ Social Sciences- Psychology, Economics, Business etc - 7,684
    - ✓ Health Sciences -100 % MEDLINE, Nursing, Dentistry - 6,740
    - ✓ Physical Sciences - Physics, Chemistry, Engineering - 7,410,
    - ✓ Life Sciences – Biology, Neuroscience, Pharmacology -4,436

Thus, it delivers the most comprehensive overview of the world's research output in the fields of science, Engineering, medicine, social sciences, arts and humanities.
