Staff Development Centre (SDC) - University of Jaffna Progress report -2022

The main objectives of the SDC are to engage in continuous improvement of the human resources capacity of the University of Jaffna and thereby promote allegiance of the staff to the University's vision and core values; introduce modern and innovative technologies and tools into the business of the University, and thereby improve the relevant knowledge and competencies and attitudes of the all categories of staff at all levels to provide the best learning experience to the students. In the pursuit of the above objectives, the SDC conducted the following training workshops/webinars for the staff of the University of Jaffna and the other HEIs and the community.

1. Induction Programme(IP) for Probationary Staff

Induction of a new academic recruit into the University System has become an indispensable component in the endeavour of building the career path of an academic employee. Going along with this principle, the UGC has declared that successful completion of an orientation program is compulsory for all academic recruits to obtain confirmation. Accordingly, the Staff Development Centres (SDC) of the University of Jaffna conducts the induction programme every year. Duration of the programme is three months with 150 contact hours. The successful completion of the induction programme fulfils the requirement for newly recruited staff members to successfully complete a Staff Development Programme for the purpose of confirmation in their positions as stipulated by the UGC Circular No.721.

The SDC hosted an inaugural ceremony for the participants of the Induction Programme for probationary staff -2022 on 27th May 2022. About one hundred staff (including ten staff from other HEIs such as University of Vavuniya, Trincomalee Campus of the Eastern University of Sri Lanka and University College of Jaffna) participated in the induction Programme. A certificate giving ceremony for the participants who successfully completed the Induction Programme in 2021 was also held on the same day. The Vice chancellor handed over the certificates to the participants.

The last session of the Induction Programme for probationary staff-2022 was held on 14.10.2022 with concluding remarks of the Vice Chancellor. The SDC earned LKR 198,000 from the above programme. Following lectures/workshops were conducted for the participants of the Induction Programme 2022.


